Completed entries (all three signatures, a copy of a negative 2017 Coggins and <b>(NEW FOR 2017 NWDA SCHOOLING SHOWS)</b> a copy of a USEF 2017 Vaccine record) must be mailed/submitted to the show secretary. Entries must be legible and must be postmarked by the closing date. Entries accepted on a first come first serve basis. Entries may close early if time limits for judges are filled. <b>Awards:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Dressage Divisions (Junior/Young, Adult Amateur, Open ) will be run concurrently as one class and pinned separately. Riders must clearly specify division choice. When no designation is made, riders will automatically be entered as OPEN -- exhibitors enter with this understanding and agreement.</li> <li>• Hunter/Jumper divisions will be pinned together as one.</li> <li>• Riders may enter only one division per class. Ribbons to 6<sup>th</sup> place.</li> </ul>	

<b>Highpoint:</b>	<p>Dressage Highpoint Awards will be pinned by division (JR/YR, AA, Open) each day with a handicap system for Training Level and up. Introductory Level will be awarded highpoint separately as one division (JR/YR &amp; AA) excluding Open division riders.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Training Level % + 0 Points  First Level % + 1 Point  Second Level % + 2 Points  Third Level &amp; Above % + 3 Points</p> <p>Hunter/Jumper Highpoint Awards will be pinned for the whole weekend</p>

<b>Championship Classes August ONLY:</b>	<p>Horse/Rider Combos qualify by receiving score of %60+ or higher at the highest test of the level at any show (NWDA or Non-NWDA) during the 2017 show season. Proof is required at time of entry.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Tests ridden by memory</li> <li>• No whip</li> <li>• Highest test of the level</li> <li>• Horses must be braided</li> <li>• Show jacket/solid colored polo shirt and breeches of light color</li> <li>• Must be present at awards ceremony in full show attire</li> </ul>

<b>Late Entries:</b>	<p>\$20 - All late entries via mail postmarked date &amp; online will be assessed a late fee.</p>				
<b>Non-competing horses:</b>	<p>\$20 per day - for horses on grounds and not competing in the show. Must fill out entry form for number, pay office fee and stabling.</p>				
<b>Confirmation of Entry:</b>	<p>Confirmation of entry will be e-mailed to the rider. All e-mail addresses must be clearly printed. Make sure you turn off your spam filter for Fox Village.</p>				
<b>Payment:</b>	<p>Payment is due at the time entries are mailed to show management. This competition accepts payment with personal check, cashier's check or money order. Entries not accompanied by fees will be considered late and not entered until fees are received including any late or post entry fees. Online entries taken at <a href="http://www.equestrianentries.com">www.equestrianentries.com</a> with a credit card or echeck. Make checks payable to NORTH WOODS DRESSAGE ASSOCIATION or NWDA.</p>				
<b>Entry Cancellation and Refunds:</b>	<p>There will be no refunds given after the closing date without a written Veterinary or Doctors note. The note must be received by NWDA no more than 30 calendar days from the closing date. The NWDA Board will review each request on a case by case basis. Refunds that are deemed appropriate will be given in show credit form for the amount of the <i>class fees</i> ONLY.</p>				
<b>Ride Times:</b>	<p>Unofficial ride times will posted to <a href="http://www.foxvillage.com">www.foxvillage.com</a> no later than Tuesday before the show. It is the responsibility of the rider to inform show management of any time conflicts as soon as possible after receiving the unofficial ride times. Official ride times will be posted in the show office by NOON the day before the competition starts.</p>				

<b>Stabling:</b>	Stall deposit required for each entry to be refunded after management ok's clean stall. Initial bedding is not provided. You may bring your own shavings. <b>No straw, pelleted or paper bedding.</b> Shavings may be ordered on entry for \$8 per bag or purchased at the show while supplies last. All horses must be stabled; no jump-outs allowed. <b>Stabling is available after 3:00 pm the day before the show. No early arrivals unless prearranged with show management.</b>
<b>Camper/RV Hook –up/Tenting:</b>	\$25 per night – Camping/RV Hook-Up will be assigned on a “first come, first serve” based upon receipt of entry. Tenting \$15 per night.
<b>Weather/Acts of God/Accidents or Emergency Policy:</b>	Management reserves the right to cancel any classes due to hazardous weather, Acts of God, Accidents or Emergencies. No refunds for cancellations due to hazardous weather, Acts of God, Accidents or Emergencies.
<b>Arenas/Footing:</b>	Two standard 20m x 60m competition rings, both with sand footing. The warm-up is sand footing or sand over grass. No lunging in large warm-up ring on show days; lunging only in grass area or sand round pen (horse must be on a lunge line-NO FREE LUNGING). The Competition Arenas may be ridden in until sundown Friday evening. Saturday use of the warm up and competition rings is available at the conclusion of the show Saturday until sundown.
<b>Medical:</b>	Medical personnel will be on grounds. Ambulance on call.
<b>Farrier:</b>	On call.

<b>Other:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Dogs are not permitted to be loose on competition grounds and must be on a leash</li> <li>• Smoking is not permitted in or near barns, show office or competition arena/warm-up.</li> </ul>
<b>Accommodations:</b>	Lumbermen’s Inn (Iron River): 715-372-4515; Rustic Roost (Iron River): 715-372-4426; Brule River Motel (Brule): 715-372-4817.
<b>Directions:</b>	I-35 North to Highway 2 East (exit 253A). Cross the bay into Superior, WI. Turn left at stoplight. Follow Highway 2 (Belknap St) to Barker’s Island. Turn right at junction of Highways 2 and 53. Follow Highways 2/53 out of Superior. Hwy 53 will split off to the right/South. Take Hwy 2, the LEFT split and continue to follow Hwy 2 through Wentworth, Poplar, and Brule. Before the Town of Iron River, there is a lake on the right and a sign on the right hand side of the road that says, “Fairgrounds.” Turn left and follow to fairgrounds, approx. ¼ mile.
